Request to accept dedication of public water main improvements on Watertown Plank Road from 118th Street in Wauwatosa to Church Street in the Village of Elm Grove

Submitted by: David Simpson Department Public Works

A. Issue

The City of Wauwatosa has agreed to serve a portion of the Village of Elm Grove with retail water service through privately funded water main extensions. A portion of that water main extension is now ready to be dedicated to the City of Wauwatosa.

B. Background/Options

In early 2022 the City of Wauwatosa and the Village of Elm Grove entered into an agreement that allows Wauwatosa to serve a portion of Elm Grove with retail water service. In late 2022 Wauwatosa entered into an agreement with the Developer of the School Sisters of Notre Dame site in which the Developer agreed to construct water main improvements at their cost and to dedicate those improvements to the City. At this time a significant portion of the water main improvements have been completed and are ready for dedication (see Exhibit B of the attachment). The remaining portion of the water main improvements will be completed this spring once weather allows at which time I will formally acknowledge and accept the remaining dedication of improvements if authorized by the Board and Common Council in conjunction with this dedication.

At this time I am recommending that the City accept dedication of the public water main improvements as shown on the attached document.

D. Fiscal Impact

No cost to the City. The City will be receiving millions of dollars of replacement and new water infrastructure as part of the dedication process.

DEDICATION OF IMPROVEMENTS LOCATED ALONG WATERTOWN PLANK ROAD BETWEEN 118TH STREET IN THE CITY OF WAUWATOSA, MILWAUKEE COUNTY, WISCONSIN AND CHURCH STREET IN THE VILLAGE OF ELM GROVE, WAUKESHA COUNTY, WISCONSIN

THIS DEDICATION OF IMPROVEMENTS (this "Dedication") is executed as of February, ______, 2024 (the "Effective Date") by CAROLINE HEIGHTS APARTMENTS LLC, a Wisconsin limited liability company (the "Dedicator") and the CITY OF WAUWATOSA, a Wisconsin municipal corporation (the "Municipality").

RECITALS

- A. The Dedicator is the fee holder of certain real property in the Village of Elm Grove, Waukesha County, State of Wisconsin, as more particularly described on the attached and incorporated <u>Exhibit</u> <u>A</u> (the "**Property**").
- B. The Dedicator and the Municipality have entered into an Agreement Between City of Wauwatosa and Caroline Heights Apartments LLC to Provide for the Construction of a Water Extension for a Water System dated October 7, 2022 (the "Water Agreement") pursuant to which Dedicator constructed those certain improvements within the public right-of-way known as Watertown Plank Road near and adjacent to the Property, as further described in the Water Agreement (the "Improvements").
- C. The Municipality and the Village of Elm Grove entered into an Agreement between the City of Wauwatosa and the Village of Elm Grove to Allow a Water Extension for a Water System (the "Municipality Agreement") pursuant to which the Village of Elm Grove has agreed to grant the Municipality the necessary interests in the land underlying the Improvements for the City's access to, construction, and maintenance of the Improvements.
- D. Pursuant to the terms of the Water Agreement, Dedicator has constructed certain Improvements and Dedicator wishes to dedicate and convey the Improvements to the Municipality. Improvements completed and dedicated with approval of this agreement are shown on <u>Exhibit B</u>. Dedication and acceptance of the remaining water main and appurtenances contemplated in the Water Agreement shall be finalized upon written approval by the City of Wauwatosa Director of Public Works.

DEDICATION

In consideration of the mutual agreements contained herein and in the Water Agreement, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. **Dedication of Improvements**. Dedicator hereby conveys and dedicates all of Dedicator's interests in and to the Improvements to the Municipality. Dedicator represents and warrants that the Improvements are free and clear of all construction liens related to the work performed on behalf of Dedicator.

- 2. Acceptance by Municipality. The Municipality hereby accepts the dedication of the Improvements from Dedicator. The Municipality represents and warrants that all obligations of Dedicator for design and construction of the Improvements, as described in the Water Agreement, have been completed to the satisfaction of the City Engineer and the Improvements comply with City of Wauwatosa and Wisconsin Department of Transportation standards. As further set forth in the Water Agreement, Municipality hereby agrees to perform (i) all necessary operation, maintenance, repair and replacement activities on the Improvements so that the Improvements will be maintained in a neat and workmanlike manner and in accordance with the Water Agreement and the Municipality Agreement, (ii) all future capital improvements associated with the Improvements, and (iii) all other Municipality responsibilities set forth under the Water Agreement and the Effective Date hereof, the Municipality shall be solely responsible for the operation, maintenance, repair and replacement (collectively, the "Municipality Responsibilities"). From and after the Effective Date hereof, the Municipality shall be solely responsible for the operation, maintenance, repair and replacement of the Water Distribution Facilities as defined in the Water Agreement.
- 3. **Easement and Access Rights**. The Municipality and Dedicator hereby acknowledge and agree that Municipality shall have such rights of access and easements to the Improvements as may be set forth in the Municipality Agreement or as may be otherwise agreed by the Municipality and the Village of Elm Grove.
- 4. **Governing Law.** This Dedication shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Wisconsin.
- 5. **Counterparts**. This Dedication may be executed in any number of counterparts, and each counterpart shall be deemed to be an original instrument, but all such counterparts together shall constitute one agreement.

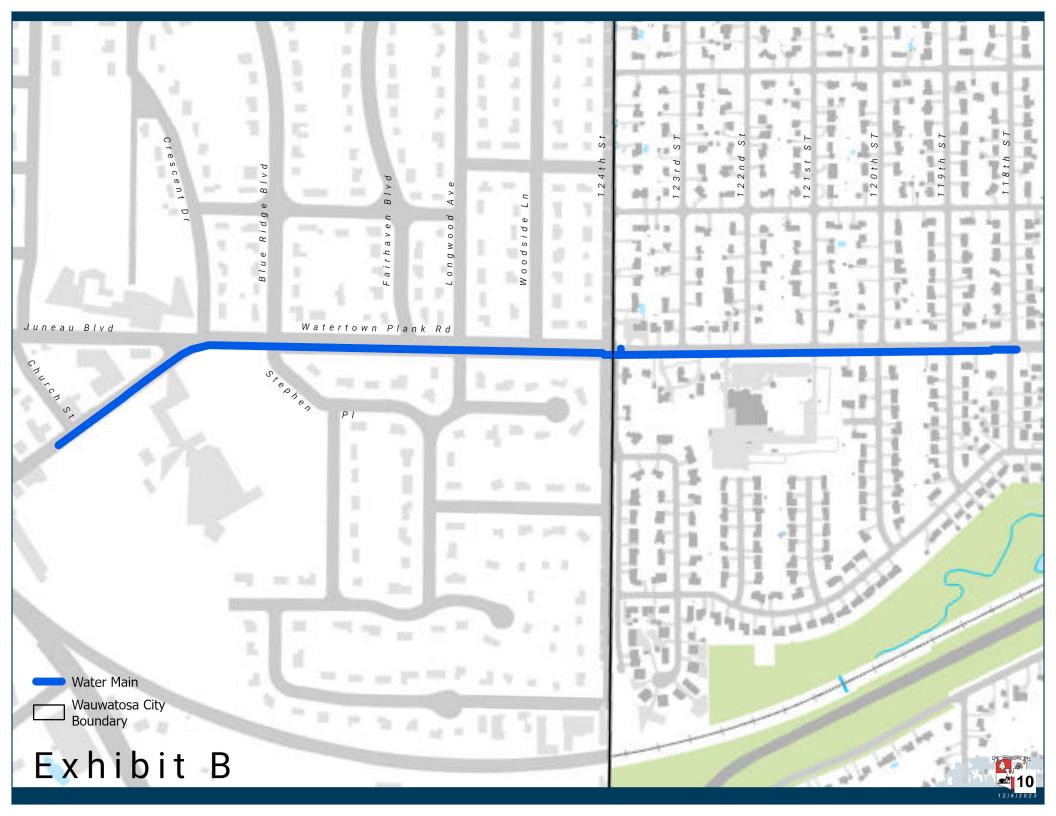

A. Issue

The Engineering Services Division is requesting acceptance of an Easement for Water Main at 3900 N. 124th Street.

B. Background/Options

In 2009 a 12- inch public water main was installed on the north and west sides of the Target building at 3900 N. 124th Street as part of the redevelopment of the site at that time. Neither the City nor the property owner have records that the proposed 20-foot-wide easement was accepted by the City or recorded at the County. The water main and hydrants within this proposed easement are current City assets and are maintained as such. This document will formalize a public easement within this property.

EASEMENT FOR WATER MAIN

THIS EASEMENT FOR WATER MAIN (the "Agreement") is made as of the ______ day of ______, 2024, by TARGET CORPORATION, a Minnesota corporation ("Grantor") to the City of Wauwatosa, Wisconsin, a municipal corporation (the "City").

RECITALS:

A. Grantor is the owner of certain real property located at 3900 N. 124th St., Wauwatosa, WI 53222, as more particularly described on the attached and incorporated <u>Exhibit A</u> ("Grantor's Property").

B. In consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Grantor does hereby quitclaim unto the City, subject to the terms and conditions set forth below, a perpetual non-exclusive easement ("Easement") for the specific purpose of permitting the City the right to operate, maintain, repair, remove and replace an existing water main (collectively called the "Facilities") under the surface of a portion of Grantor's Property being ten (10) feet on either side of the center line of the currently existing Easement, approximately located in the area as shown on the site plan attached hereto, legally described, and made a part hereof as <u>Exhibit B</u> ("Easement Area"), together with the right of reasonable and necessary ingress and egress to and from the Easement Area in connection with the exercise of the rights granted herein.

AGREEMENT

1. Incorporation of Recitals. The foregoing recitals are true, correct, and incorporated herein and made a part of this Agreement.

2. Indemnification. The City shall indemnify and hold harmless Grantor, their tenants, invitees, designees, assignees, and licensees from and against all loss, costs (including reasonable attorney fees), injury, death, or damage to persons, property, or business that at any time during the term of this Agreement may be suffered or sustained by any person or entity in connection with the City's activities conducted on Grantor's Property. The City shall also require that all its agents or contractors have adequate insurance for the purpose of indemnifying and holding Grantor harmless from such agents' or contractors' negligence in the use, operation, installation, repair, replacement and maintenance of the Easement in the Easement Area.

3. Consistent Uses Allowed. Except as currently in existence or contemplated at the time of this Agreement, Grantor shall not at any time erect or maintain in or upon the Easement Area any permanent or temporary buildings or any similar structure without express written permission of the City and shall not unreasonably interfere with the City's enjoyment of the rights granted in this Agreement. The City shall exercise reasonable efforts and coordinate its activities with Grantor and their invitees to minimize disruption to the Grantor's Property, the Easement Area, and the businesses

operated thereon.

4. Conduct of Work and Notification. Any maintenance, replacement, repair and/or removal of the Facilities performed by the City, its agents and employees must be performed (i) at the City's sole cost and expense, (ii) during months other than November, December or January (except in the event of an emergency) and after thirty (30) days' notice to the Grantor (except that in an emergency the work may be initiated after reasonable notice). In addition, the City, its agents and employees must (a) promptly pay all costs and expenses associated with said work and (b) diligently complete such work as quickly as possible.

5. Repairs; Restoration of Surface. The City, at its sole cost and expense, shall restore the surface disturbed by any construction or maintenance of any equipment located within the Easement Area such that any improvements, infrastructure, or landscaping so disturbed are restored to a level consistent with the surrounding improvements, infrastructure, or landscaping. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the City shall not be required to replace or repair extraordinary improvements, such as electronic signage, that was not identified in the plans for Grantor's Property as of the date of this Agreement, is built directly over the water main, and which is not practical to avoid while undertaking the work. For example, if the curb line is removed or damaged in part of the area, the curb line will be replaced or repaired to at least the same level or condition as the existing curb line. However, if a new electronic pylon sign not previously included in the plans is placed in the Easement Area, the City would only be required to restore the basic infrastructure.

6. **Prohibition Against Liens.** The City must not permit any mechanics', materialmen's or other liens to be filed against Grantor's Property or any part thereof for work or materials furnished the City in connection with the Easement, and Grantee agrees to indemnify, defend and hold Grantor harmless from and against the same.

7. Covenants Run with Land. All of the terms and conditions in this Agreement, including the benefits and burdens, shall run with the land and shall be binding upon, inure to the benefit of, and be enforceable by Grantor and the City and their respective successors and assigns, provided however, any liability or obligation of Grantor under this Agreement will terminate with respect to future facts or circumstances arising upon the transfer of its fee simple interest in the Easement Area.

8. **Recording; Term**. This Easement shall be recorded in the Office of the Register of Deeds for Milwaukee County, Wisconsin. The term of this Easement shall commence on the date that it is filed of record in the Register of Deeds and shall continue in perpetuity.

9. Non-Use. Non-use or limited use of the Easement Area rights granted in this Agreement shall not prevent the benefiting party from later use of the Easement Area rights to the fullest extent authorized in this Agreement.

10. Governing Law. This Easement shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Wisconsin.

11. Entire Agreement. This Agreement sets forth the entire understanding of the parties and may not be changed except by a written document executed and acknowledged by all parties to this Agreement and duly recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds.

12. Notices. All notices required or permitted to be given under this Agreement must be in writing, sent to all parties, sent postage prepaid, by either certified or registered mail, return receipt requested or nationally recognized overnight courier, and shall be deemed to have been given as of the date such notice is (i) delivered to the then current address of the party intended, or (ii) rejected at the then current address of the party intended. Upon at least ten (10) days' prior written notice, each party shall have the right to change its address to any other address within the United States of America.

13. Invalidity. If any term or condition of this Agreement, or the application of this Agreement to any person or circumstance, shall be deemed invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of this Agreement, or the application of the term or condition to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid or unenforceable, shall not be affected thereby, and each term and condition shall be valid and enforceable to the fullest extent permitted by law.

14. Waiver. No delay or omission by any party in exercising any right or power arising out of any default under any of the terms or conditions of this Agreement shall be

construed to be a waiver of the right or power. A waiver by a party of any of the obligations of the other party shall not be construed to be a waiver of any breach of any other terms or conditions of this Agreement.

15. Enforcement. Enforcement of this Agreement may be by proceedings at law or in equity against any person or persons violating or attempting or threatening to violate any term or condition in this Agreement, either to restrain or prevent the violation or to obtain any other relief. If a suit is brought to enforce this Agreement, the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover its costs, including reasonable attorney fees, from the non-prevailing party.

16. No Public Dedication. Nothing in this Agreement shall be deemed to be a gift or dedication of any portion of the easements granted under this Agreement to the general public.

17. Counterparts; Headings. This Agreement may be executed in several counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be an original. The signature of the parties hereto on this Agreement may be executed and notarized on separate pages, and when attached to this Agreement shall constitute one complete document. The headings contained in this Agreement are for convenience of reference only and shall not affect the meaning or interpretation of this Agreement.

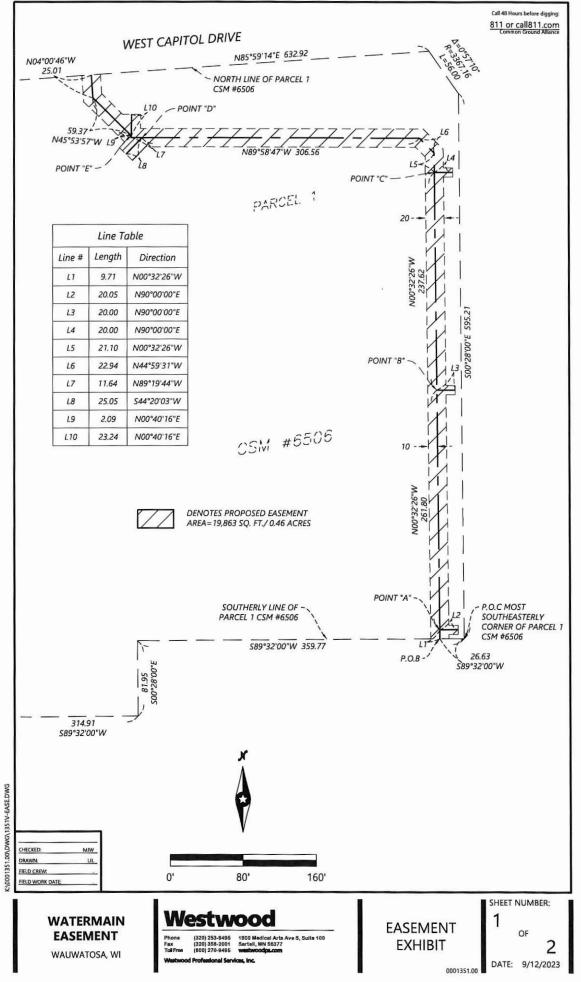

A. Issue

Curb ramps, landings, and traffic signal upgrades are required at the 124th Street and Lisbon Avenue intersection to comply with ADA standards due to pathway construction along Lisbon Road in the City of Brookfield.

B. Background/Options

124th Street is bifurcated with the City of Wauwatosa on the east and City of Brookfield on the west. On September 22, 1999, Wauwatosa and Brookfield entered into an agreement for the installation, ownership, liability, maintenance and operation of traffic signals at the 124th Street and Lisbon Road intersection (attached). The agreement requires the Wauwatosa to make any necessary equipment additions or revisions deemed necessary by changed laws or changed traffic

conditions, with a 50/50 cost-share from Brookfield for any equipment, additions, or revisions necessary to comply with changed laws or traffic conditions.

Brookfield is planning to add a pathway along the south side of Lisbon Road, west of 124th Street, as part of a pavement project on Lisbon Road. The addition of sidewalk requires the addition of curb ramps, landings, and traffic signal upgrades at the 124th Street and Lisbon Road intersection to comply with ADA standards.

Brookfield requested that Wauwatosa enter into an intermunicipal agreement to allow for the intersection upgrades to be designed and constructed through Brookfield's Lisbon Road project in Year 2024 (attached) Under the agreement, each city will pay 50/50 for traffic signal equipment, additions, or revisions necessary to comply with changed laws or traffic conditions. Additionally, each city will pay for modifications to access ramps and landings within their municipality. Brookfield will pay up front costs and invoice for Wauwatosa's share of the project cost upon performance of their contractor's obligations. The intermunicipal agreement will be satisfied upon project completion and the terms of the 1999 agreement will continue.

C. Strategic Plan (Area of Focus)

Priority 2: Public Safety, Goal 2. Proactively address pedestrian, bicycle, and vehicular safety. Priority 3: Infrastructure, Goal 2. Ensure the City's infrastructure supports public health through multimodal transportation and recreation opportunities.

D. Fiscal Impact

The estimated project cost for the City of Wauwatosa is \$105,215.

E. Recommendation

Approve the intermunicipal agreement between the City of Brookfield and the City of Wauwatosa to upgrade pedestrian facilities and associated traffic controls at the 124th Street and Lisbon Road intersection to Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards due to pathway construction along Lisbon Road in the City of Brookfield.

INTERMUNICIPAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF WAUWATOSA AND THE CITY OF BROOKFIELD FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNALS, AND MARKING AND SIGNING IN NORTH 124TH STREET AT WEST LISBON ROAD

This agreement is made and entered into by and between the City of Wauwatosa, a Municipal Corporation, hereinafter called "Wauwatosa", and the City of Brookfield, a Municipal Corporation, hereinafter called "Brookfield", relating to the installation, ownership, liability, maintenance, and operation of traffic control signals and related traffic control facilities at the intersection of North 124th Street and West Lisbon Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises of each governmental agency made to the other, the fulfillment of terms and conditions, agreements and understandings hereinafter set forth and pursuant to §66.30 of the Wisconsin Statutes;

IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED, by and between the parties, that it is considered desirable and in the best interests of public safety and convenience that traffic signals be installed at the intersection of North 124th Street and West Lisbon Road along with other traffic related facilities as approved by the State of Wisconsin Department of Transportation and as shown on the Plan of Proposed Signalization attached hereto and made a part of this agreement.

CONDITIONS OF THIS AGREEMENT ARE TO BE AS FOLLOWS:

1. Wauwatosa hereby agrees:

4 A

- a) That it or its agents will pay the total cost of installation for the traffic signals.
- b) That it will, through its Electrical Maintenance Unit, or agents, assume all routine maintenance responsibility including, but not limited to, lamp replacement, cleaning, lens replacement, traffic control signal and control cabinet painting and controller services.
- c) That it or its agents will make all necessary repairs and install replacements on equipment which fails to function properly as a result of normal wear and deterioration and that it will pay the full cost for such repair and/or replacement.
- d) That it or its agents will make all necessary repairs and replacements to equipment damaged by accident, vandalism, or act of God and will pay the full cost of such repairs.

- e) That it will pay for any subsequent modifications to the traffic signal installation due to future alterations of the intersection geometry within the corporate limits of Wauwatosa after the initial installation is complete.
- f) That it or its agents will pay the full cost of operation (electrical energy) of the said traffic signals.
- g) That it or its agents will make any necessary equipment additions or revisions deemed necessary by changed laws or changed traffic conditions, and will pay for one-half of said work after obtaining concurrence from Brookfield prior to equipment additions or revisions.
- h) That it will maintain the design, installation and operation of the traffic control signals in compliance with the regulations of the State of Wisconsin and the Federal Uniform Manual of Traffic Control Devices.
- That it will operate and adjust the traffic signal timing and equipment in such manner as to best meet prevailing traffic conditions and as mutually agreed to by Brookfield.
- 2. Brookfield hereby agrees:
 - a) To permit the City of Wauwatosa or its agents to enter the public rights of way in the City of Brookfield at no fee for the purpose of operating and maintaining the signal and related equipment.
 - b) To pay one-half of the cost of any equipment, additions, or revisions necessary to comply with changed laws or traffic conditions.
 - c) That Wauwatosa will perform all work related to maintenance and operation of the traffic control signals at the subject intersection, including engineering, except such immediate emergency measures as may need to be taken, should Wauwatosa forces not be present and where the public safety may be in jeopardy, and Brookfield officers or employees deem such measures necessary. Costs for such emergency action will be reimbursed to Brookfield upon receipt of an invoice.
 - d) That it agrees to notify Wauwatosa through its Public Works or Police Department of any observed damage, lamp outage, lens breakage, or seeming malfunction of traffic control signal equipment or related traffic control devices.
 - e) To reimburse Wauwatosa for any future costs incurred in modifying traffic control signals and related equipment due to alterations of the intersection geometry within the corporate limits of Brookfield after the initial

installation is completed.

- 3. Ownership: All equipment shall be owned equally.
- 4. Payments: All payments due under this agreement shall be paid within forty-five (45) days after receipt of invoice of same.
- 5. Brookfield and Wauwatosa hereby agree that all necessary pavement marking and signing on North 124th Street at West Lisbon Road located within the corporate boundaries of each municipality respectively shall be by and at the expense of the municipality in which such signing and marking is located.
- 6. Liability: Wauwatosa shall request layouts of Brookfield's underground structure and facilities before performing work of such a nature that existing underground facilities must be avoided. Wauwatosa shall take precautionary measures to avoid damage to such underground facilities. Brookfield shall supply Wauwatosa with a complete record of the existing underground material structure at the intersection and median crossover and of changes or revisions thereto as may take place in the future.

In the event that any person or persons make claim for injury or damages arising from alleged negligent maintenance of the traffic control facilities covered by this agreement, Wauwatosa shall defend against such claim(s) and shall be responsible for the payment of any claim(s) for injury (or death) of any person(s) or for damage or destruction of any property. In the event that person or persons make claim for personal injury (including death) or damage or destruction of property arising out of the installation or operation of the traffic control facilities covered by this agreement which does not arise out of negligent maintenance of the traffic control facilities covered by this agreement, both municipalities shall defend against such claim(s) and, if liability and consequential damages are awarded to any person or persons from such a claim, each governmental body shall pay that portion of said claim as it may be found liable therefore. In the event that any claim by person or persons is based on a street defect (§81.15 of the Wisconsin Statutes, 1969), the defense and the liability therefore shall be the obligation of the municipality which has maintenance responsibility for that roadway.

7. Duration: This agreement shall continue and be in force indefinitely unless terminated by a six (6) month advance written notice from either municipality to the other.

INTERMUNICIPAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF BROOKFIELD AND THE CITY OF WAUWATOSA.

This Intermunicipal Agreement (this "Agreement"), dated as of January 16, 2024 (the "Effective Date"), is made pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 66.0301, and by and between the City of Brookfield ("Brookfield") and the City of Wauwatosa ("Wauwatosa"), both municipal corporations organized and existing under the laws of the State of Wisconsin.

WHEREAS, on September 22, 1999, Wauwatosa and Brookfield entered into an Agreement for the installation, ownership, liability, maintenance and operation of traffic control signals at the intersection of North 124th Street and West Lisbon Road (the "1999 Agreement");

WHEREAS, under the 1999 Agreement, the parties agreed to construct and operate traffic signals at the intersection of North 124th Street and West Lisbon Road located in both Wauwatosa and Brookfield, which is depicted on the map attached to this Agreement as Exhibit A (the "Intersection");

WHEREAS, as of the Effective Date, the Intersection, in part, includes traffic control signals, relocated traffic control facilities, and pedestrian facilities;

WHEREAS, the pedestrian facilities and associated traffic controls require upgrades to Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards (the "Project"), due to reconstruction and pathway construction along Lisbon Road;

WHEREAS, the parties desire to enter into this Agreement to establish the phasing and sharing of costs for the Project in accordance with the conditions of the 1999 Agreement and as further described in this Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants set forth herein, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. Project Bidding and Construction. The Project bidding documents shall be approved by Brookfield and Wauwatosa. Upon approval of the bidding documents, Brookfield will post and administer the bidding process for the Project in compliance with Wis. Stat. § 62.15. Wauwatosa shall execute any necessary documents to assist Brookfield in carrying out the posting and administering of the bidding process. If a bid is approved and the contract with the bidder is successfully executed, Brookfield shall be responsible for the design and supervision of the Project.

2. Cost Share. In accordance with the 1999 Agreement, the parties shall share in the total actual cost of the Project as further described on the Cost Sharing Schedule attached as **Exhibit B** (the "Cost Schedule") and incorporated herein. The parties acknowledge that the Cost Schedule is only an estimate. If the cost for a portion of the Project exceeds the amount identified on the Cost Schedule, then the party responsible for payment of that portion of the Project must pay the additional cost.

3. **Payment**. Brookfield will pay both parties' Project costs upfront and make regular payments to the contractor awarded the Project bid upon performance of contractor's obligations under such contract. Wauwatosa will reimburse Brookfield for Wauwatosa's share of the Project Cost upon 45 days of receipt of an invoice from Brookfield. Brookfield will send invoices to Wauwatosa at NAME AND EMAIL.

4. **Phasing**. The Project is anticipated to be completed as described on the Project Schedule attached to this Agreement as **Exhibit C** (the "Project Schedule").

5. Miscellaneous. This Agreement may not be amended or terminated without the written consent of the parties. This Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties, and their respective successors and assigns. Any dispute arising out of or relating to this Agreement must be commenced in Waukesha County Circuit Court and must be interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Wisconsin. This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which when executed and delivered shall be deemed an original, but such counterparts together shall constitute but one and the same document. If any provision of this Agreement is deemed invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of this Agreement shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect.

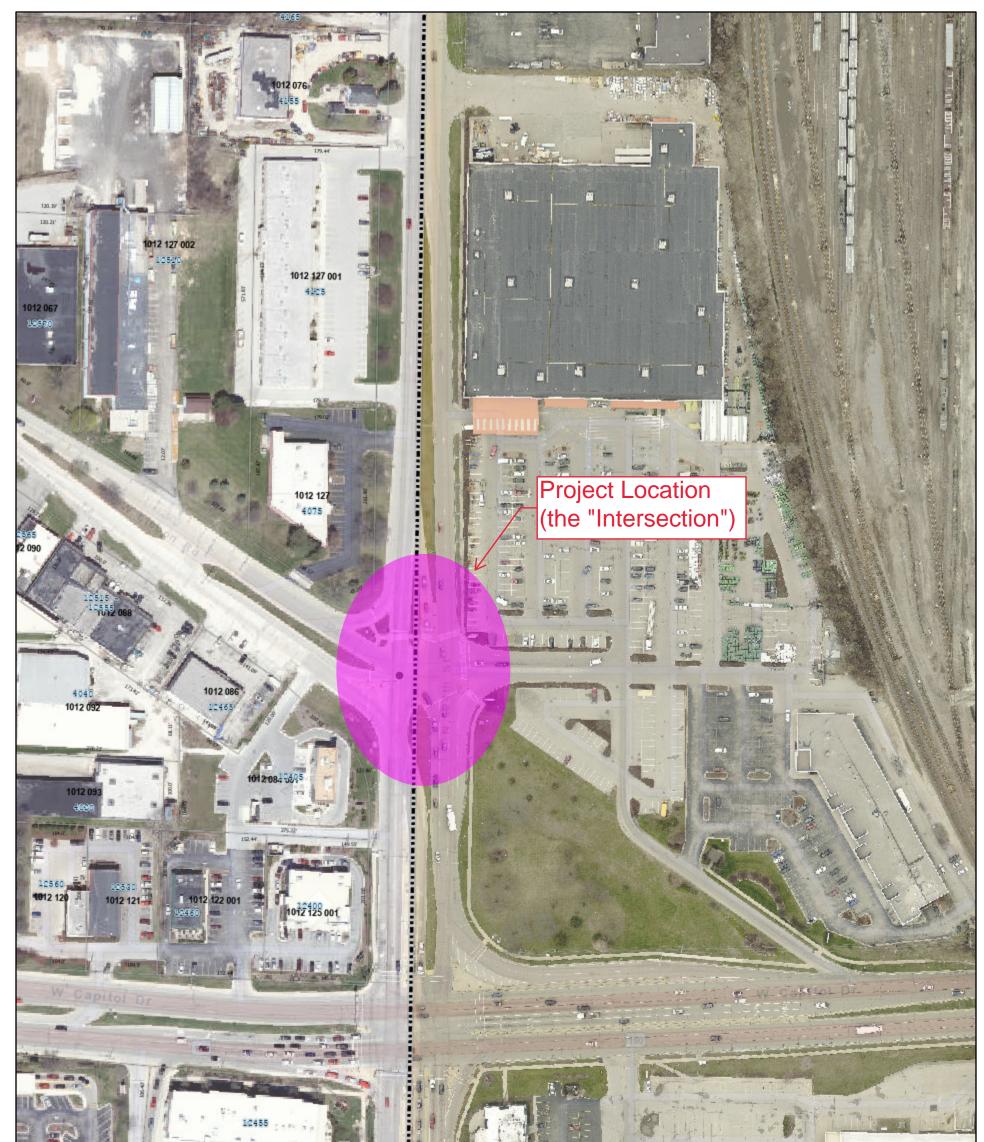

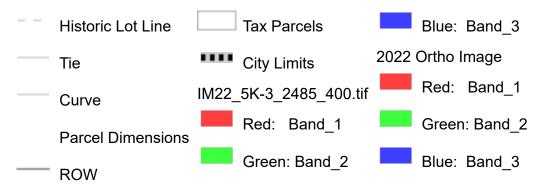
Project Location Map

A. Issue

Declaration of the City's intent to perform street and alley improvements during the 2024 construction season and to request the Common Council assess neighboring property owners and set a public hearing date of February 20, 2024

B. Background/Options

It has been the City of Wauwatosa's long-standing practice to issue special assessments for public construction projects. This board resolution declares the City's intent to special assess for 2024 paving projects as planned in the 2024 Capital Budget and start the special assessment process.

Special assessments for 2024 paving projects are included in the 2024 Capital Budget

E. Recommendation

Request the Common Council assess neighboring property owners and set a public hearing date of February 20, 2024

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the City of Wauwatosa, Wisconsin, that

<u>Section 1.</u> The Common Council of the City of Wauwatosa, Wisconsin hereby declares its intention to exercise its police power, under Section 66.0703 of the Wisconsin Statutes, to levy special assessments upon property in the City of Wauwatosa within the following described area for the benefits conferred upon such property by the repaying of:

<u>Section 2.</u> Said public improvement shall include the following work to be done during the 2023 construction season:

<u>Reconstruction: Type "A" (Asph.)</u> or (Conc.) Completely removing existing curb and gutter and existing pavement, placing new concrete curb and gutter (excluding alleys), and asphalt or concrete pavement surface on a new base.

The above repaying type also includes placing necessary water and sewer service pipes and storm sewer and appurtenances; relaying sanitary sewer and storm sewer as required; relocating existing street lighting system where necessary; constructing new concrete driveway approaches; and replacing concrete sidewalks which are disturbed by other construction, which are defective, or which have a hazard potential.

<u>Repaving Type "B" (Asph.)</u> Completely removing existing curb and gutter, milling the existing asphalt pavement as required, and placing new concrete curb and gutter and asphalt pavement surface on the existing road base.

The above repaying type also includes placing necessary water and sewer service pipes and storm sewer and appurtenances; relaying sanitary sewer and storm sewer as required; relocating existing street lighting system where necessary; constructing new concrete driveway approaches; and replacing concrete sidewalks which are disturbed by other construction, which are defective, or which have a hazard potential.

<u>Repaving: Type "C" (Asph)</u> Milling the existing pavement as required, repairing curbs (and abutting approaches and sidewalks where necessary), and surfacing with asphalt pavement. Also included is the placing of necessary water and sewer service pipes and storm sewer and appurtenances, and relaying sanitary sewer and storm sewer as required.

<u>Repaving: Type "D"</u> Replacing defective curb and gutter, removing, milling and/or pulverizing the existing pavement surface as required, and surfacing with new asphalt pavement. Also included is the placing of necessary water and sewer service pipes and storm sewer and appurtenances, and relaying sanitary sewer and storm sewer as required.

<u>Repaving: Type "E"</u> Replacing minimal defective curb and gutter, minor pavement milling, overlay existing pavement with asphalt pavement. Also included is the placing of necessary water and sewer service pipes and storm sewer and appurtenances, and relaying sanitary sewer and storm sewer as required.

<u>Section 3.</u> The total amount assessed shall be upon a reasonable basis as determined by the Common Council.

<u>Section 4.</u> That the owners of the respective parcels of land fronting or abutting the street improvements, on which a public hearing has been held and preliminary assessments have been confirmed, shall have payment of the special assessments scheduled as follows:

(a) Each special assessment and special charge, pursuant to Section 66.0703 of the Wisconsin Statutes, levied in an amount of \$200 or less against any parcel of land in the City of Wauwatosa shall be entered in the tax rolls in one installment.

(b) Each special assessment for improvements levied in an amount exceeding \$200 against any parcel of land in the City of Wauwatosa shall be entered in the tax rolls in five equal annual installments of principal together with interest at the rate of twelve percent (12%) per year or the percentage rounded out to the next highest whole percentage number above the interest rate paid by the City for the sale of corporate purpose bonds, which include the project which is the subject of the special assessment, whichever figure is less, on the unpaid balance of said assessment. Individual assessments shall run concurrently except as provided under Section 3.08.040 of the City Code.

(c) Each special assessment levied against any parcel of land in the City of Wauwatosa for the installation of sanitary sewer main or water main or construction of permanent street pavement shall not be entered in the tax roll until all installments of special assessments for sanitary sewer or water main or construction of permanent street pavement levied previously against the same parcel of land have been entered into the tax rolls and have been paid. Such subsequent special assessment shall be deferred and only interest at the rate of twelve percent (12%) per year, or the percentage rounded out to the next highest whole percentage number above the interest rate paid by the City for the issuance of General Obligation Debt, which include the project which is the subject of the special assessment, whichever figure is less, on such subsequent special assessment shall be carried into the tax rolls in addition to the scheduled installments of such prior assessments. After the last installment of such prior special assessment has been entered in the tax rolls, installments of the subsequent special assessment shall, beginning with the next subsequent tax roll, be entered in the tax rolls pursuant to Section 3.08.030 of the City Code.

(d) Whenever special assessments are levied against the frontage and side of a corner parcel of land in the City of Wauwatosa for the installation of sanitary sewers or water mains or construction of permanent pavements arising out of the same public works project, such special assessments levied against a corner parcel of land shall be deemed to be two separate special assessments, and the special assessment levied against the frontage of the corner parcel of land shall first be scheduled on the tax rolls for payment as provided in Section 3.08.030 of the City Code and the special assessment levied against the side of the corner parcel of land shall be scheduled on the tax rolls pursuant to (c) above, following such scheduling of the special assessment levied against the frontage of land.

(e) Notwithstanding the provisions of (c) and (d) above, any owners of parcels of land assessed may at their option elect to pay both the scheduled installments of prior assessments as well as scheduled installments of subsequent special assessments on the same tax rolls as entered on those tax rolls pursuant to Section 3.08.030 of the City Code.

(f) If, after special assessments have been placed on the tax rolls in installments or otherwise, the taxpayer fails to pay the same within the time allowed for payment of general taxes, the same shall become delinquent and shall be treated in the same manner and subject to the same laws as delinquent general property taxes.

<u>Section 5.</u> The properties against which the assessments are proposed are benefited. Such benefits may include, but are not necessarily limited to, enhancement of value or marketability, improved drainage, improved pedestrian safety (walks), improved vehicular access, improved skid resistance and cross sectional elements.

Section 6. The City Engineer has prepared a report consisting of:

- a) Preliminary and/or final plans and specifications for said improvements
- b) An estimate of the entire cost of the proposed improvements
- c) A schedule of the proposed assessments in connection therewith upon a reasonable basis as determined by the Board of Public Works.

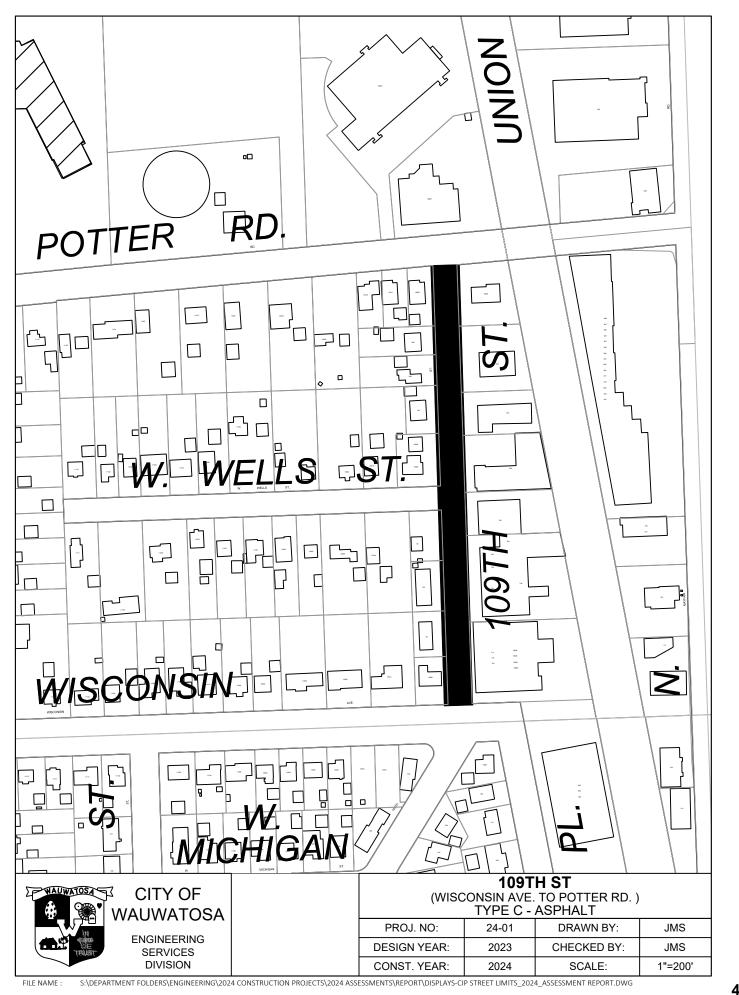
The City Engineer is directed to file a copy of these in the City Clerk's Office for public inspection.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, By the Common Council of the City of Wauwatosa, Wisconsin, that the City Clerk is directed to give notice, as by law provided, of a public hearing to all owners, to be assessed for the proposed improvements herein before listed, and to publish notice of the hearing at least once in the official newspaper at least ten days and not more than 40 days before the time set for the hearing; and

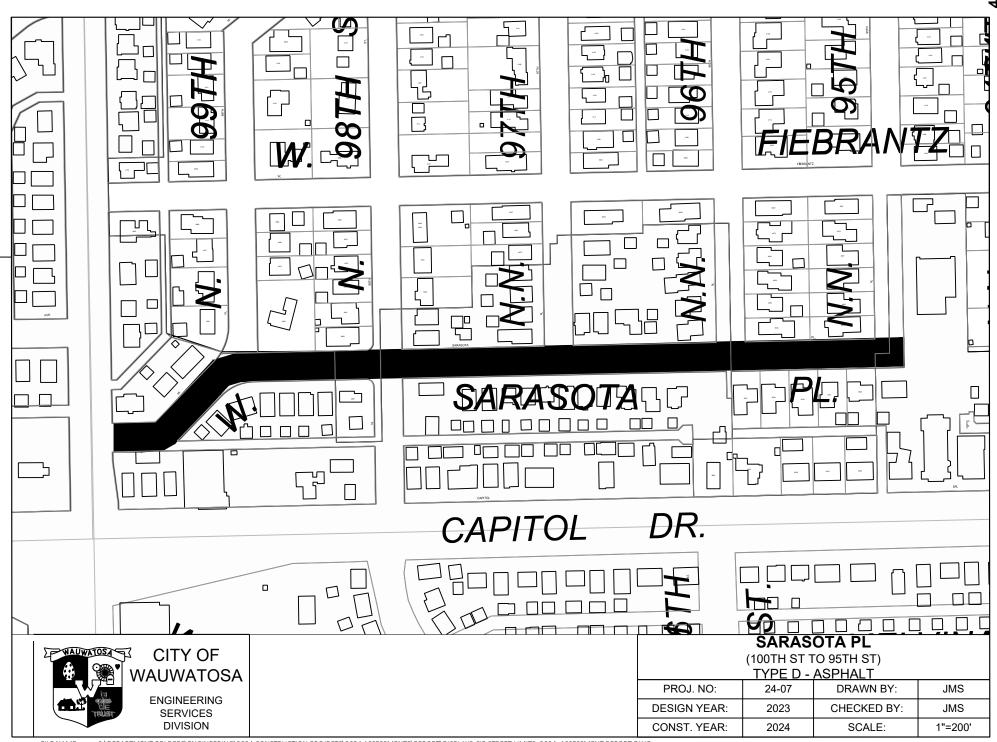

2024 Street and Alley Paving Assessments Report

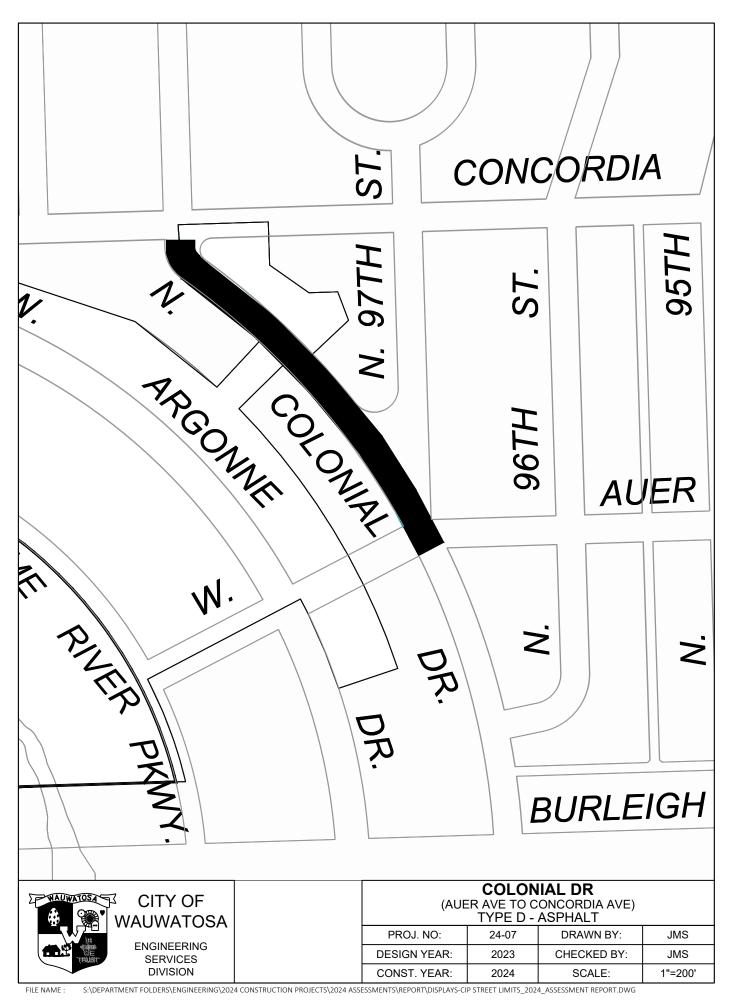

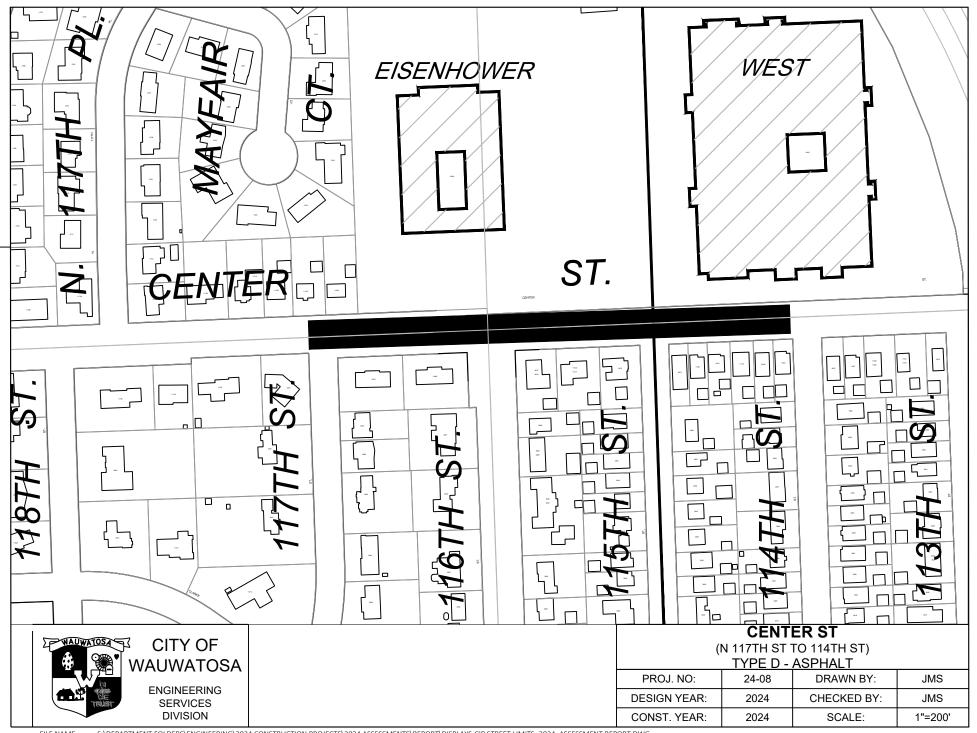

Request for approval of the attached 2024 paving assessment resolution.

B. Background/Options

Annually we update the assessment resolution. The proposed paving assessment rates for 2024 are those that were presented for 2024 in the 2024 - 2028 Capital Improvements Plan.

Options

- 1. Approve the attached 2024 assessment resolution.
- 2. Do not approve of the changes.

C. Strategic Plan (Area of Focus)

Priority Area Three: Infrastructure

D. Fiscal Impact

The proposed paving assessment rates for 2024 are those that were presented for 2024 in the 2024 - 2028 Capital Improvements Plan.

E. Recommendation

Approve the attached 2024 proposed assessment resolution.

Recommendation: Common Council

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Common Council of the City of Wauwatosa, Wisconsin that the following be and hereby are the policies for 2024 construction pertaining to utility and street improvements and corresponding rates:

- (1) Due to the relative value of the benefits conferred upon different types of properties by the public improvements described herein, assessments for original permanent pavement of streets and alleys shall be at the following rates per assessable foot based upon property classification:
 - A) \$95.20 for one or two family residences, churches, schools, public parks ("single family rate")
 - B) \$119.00 for multiple family residences of three or more (1-1/4 x single family rate)
 - C) \$142.80 for business or commercial property (1-1/2 x single family rate)
 - D) \$190.40 for industrial property (2 x single family rate)
- (1.1) A) A pavement improvement that terminates only partially abutting a parcel of land, shall have only such *prorata* portion assessed in the year that the Final Resolution is adopted by the Common Council

B) On streets that Federal and/or State Aid is not available, the rate of assessment may be adjusted to recover 60% of the paving costs.

C) On streets where the City does not have maintenance jurisdiction, the rate of assessment may be adjusted to recover 60% of the paving costs abutting each parcel.

D) On streets where sidewalks are to be newly constructed on one side only, in conjunction with a street scheduled for improvement, the cost of the sidewalk plus 25% for engineering and overhead may be prorated by total street frontage and added to the basic assessment for each property abutting said improvement or on both sides of that portion of said street.

(2) Assessments for reconstruction of a permanent pavement shall be at the following

rates per assessable foot (average width) for one or two family residences (other classes proportioned as in (1) above).

A) <u>Reconstruction Type "A"</u> \$68.00 for completely removing existing curb and pavement regrading and replacing with new concrete curb and gutter and either concrete pavement or asphaltpavement with a new road base.

B) <u>Repaving Type "B"</u> \$54.40 for completely removing existing curb and gutter, milling the existing pavement as required, and replacing with new concrete curb and gutter and asphalt pavement on the existing roadbase.

C) <u>Repaving Type "C"</u> \$27.20 for replacing defective curb and gutter, milling the existing pavement surface as required, and surfacing with new asphalt pavement or in-place recycling.

D) <u>Repaving Type "D"</u> \$34.00 for replacing defective curb and gutter, removing, milling and or pulverizing the existing pavement surface as required, and surfacing with new asphalt pavement.

E) <u>Repaving Type "E"</u> \$13.60 for minimal defective curb and gutter replacement, minor pavement milling, overlay existing pavement with asphalt pavement.

If Type "C" Repaving is required on arterial streets less than 25 years after Type "A" repaving has been performed, all one and two family residences shall receive an assessment credit equal to 4% of their previous Type "A" paving assessment for each year under 25 years.

If Type "A" repaving is required on arterial streets less than 20 years after Type "C" repaving has been performed, all one and two family residences shall receive an assessment credit equal to 5% of their previous Type "C" paving assessment for each year under 20 years.

To recover the cost of public sidewalk replacement when done in conjunction with repaying, the assessable rates may reflect an amount of \$22.00 added against each frontage foot of adjacent properties.

Sidewalk replacement when not assessed by frontage foot shall be assessed at actual cost plus the cost of engineering and overhead as described in paragraph 11, or at the fixed rate of \$315.00 per sidewalk square with nominal size of 22 to 28 square feet, for 5" thick walks and \$340.00 for 7" thick walk. When sidewalk is assessed by actual cost per square foot, the rates for 5" walk shall be no less than \$9.00 per square foot and no greater than \$13.00 per square foot, and no less than \$10.00 per square foot and no greater than \$14.00 per square foot for 7" walk.

Any property where the entire city sidewalk was replaced within twelve years may be exempt from sidewalk assessment provided walk is at proper grade and condition.

Drive approach replacement shall be assessed at actual cost plus the cost of engineering and overhead as described in paragraph 11, with a minimum assessment rate of \$10.00 per square foot and a maximum assessment rate of \$14.00 per square foot.

- (3) The assessments for reconstruction of alleys shall be at the following rates per assessable foot (average width) for one of two family residences (other classes proportioned as below).
 - A) Repaying Type "A" \$78.00 for completely removing existing alley pavement regarding and replacing with either concrete pavement or asphalt pavement with a new road base.
 - B) Repaying Type "C" \$31.20 for milling the existing pavement surface as required, and surfacing with new asphalt pavement.

The assessment rate for "green" alleys shall remain the same as if the alley was intended for standard resurfacing or reconstruction.

Property Classification Factors

- (a) 1-Unit one and two family residences, churches, schools, public parks
- (b) 1-1/2 Units three or more family residences, apartments (3 or more units
- (c) 2 Units business, commercial, industrial

Assessable Factors

- (a) Rear alley Average of front and rear lot lines.
- (b) Side alley Average of front and rear lot lines.
- (c) Rear and side alley Single assessment only: average of front and rear lot lines.

(d) One and two family lots with primary vehicle access from a public street assessed at 50% of the unit rate.

(4) (a) The front lot line is the lot line along the narrowest side of any lot that borders an existing or dedicated street lot line. The side lot line is any lot line that is not the front or rear lot line. Side lot assessments for original permanent pavement, reconstruction of permanent pavement, asphalt resurfacing, and sidewalk when assessed on a frontage foot rate, shall be assessed at the rate of 50% of the assessable side lot footage, abutting on the street being improved, for 1 and 2 family, church, school, and public park uses only. All other classes of property shall be assessed for full assessable footage.

(b) A platted or divided lot that extends through and abuts two streets, provided such lot does not consist of two or more platted or divided lots, shall have the longer of the two sides considered a side yard for purposes of assessment. The rate of assessment shall be determined as described in Paragraph (4) (a) herein.

Should both abutting frontages be equal in length, the frontage first improved or reconstructed or resurfaced, as the case may be, shall be considered the front for assessment purposes.

Irregular shaped lots may be assessed based on the actual abutting frontages, or average lot width.

(c) Properties with 3 sides adjacent to streets shall have the two longest assessable footage sides assessed at 50%. Remaining side is assessed at 100% of assessable footage.

- (5) Permanent asphalt driveway approaches placed at existing driveways, in connection with the construction of original permanent pavement, shall be assessed at cost plus 12.5% for engineering and overhead.
- (6) Concrete drive approaches installed or replaced under public contract, in connection with the construction of all permanent paving, shall be assessed at actual cost plus the cost of engineering and overhead as described in paragraph 11, with a minimum assessment rate of \$10.00 per square foot and a maximum assessment rate of \$14.00 per square foot. Concrete drive approaches six years old or less are to be replaced at no cost, and those seven to twelve years old at one-half cost.
- (7) Defective permanent curb replaced either by contract or City forces, when requested by the property owner in writing, or replacements not in connection with the resurfacing of a permanent street, shall be assessed at the rate of \$50.00 per foot replaced.
- (8) Service walk replacement shall be assessed per square foot as described in paragraphs 2 and 11, the same as sidewalk replacement.

- (9) Costs of service walks removed and replaced with sod in conjunction with permanent paving or sidewalk repair contract are not assessed to abutting property owners.
- (10) Sidewalk, driveway approaches, and service walk removal and replacement, when not done in conjunction with permanent paving or when ordered replaced by the Board of Public Works due to deterioration or defective condition, when done under public contract, shall be assessed per paragraph 2 or at cost plus 25% for engineering and overhead. Sidewalks and service walks when not done in conjunction with permanent paving, which require replacement because of city tree roots damaging same, shall receive a 1/3 credit.
- (11) To recover the cost of engineering and overhead in connection with repaving and related work involving special assessments, a charge of 12.5% shall be made against the contract amount of such work, unless a different amount is specifically stated in this resolution.
- (12) Drive approaches, sidewalk, service walk, and/or sodding replaced under public contract in excess of that required for construction of all permanent paving as determined by the Engineering Services Division, when requested by the property owner in writing, shall be assessed at actual cost plus the cost of engineering and overhead as described in paragraph 11 or at the unit rates in paragraph 2.
- (13) Federal, state, and railroad properties are exempt from special assessments.
- (14) Street projects that have been postponed shall be assessed at the rate the project was originally approved by the Common Council unless the Common Council subsequently sets a new rate.
- (15) Special assessments in amounts greater than \$5,000.00 can be paid in annual installments up to ten (10) years.
- (16) Private sanitary sewer, sanitary laterals, storm sewer and/or storm laterals replaced under public contract in excess of that required for construction of publicly owned utilities as determined by the Engineering Services Division, when requested by the property owner in writing, shall be assessed at actual cost plus 10% for engineering and overhead.
- (17) Private sanitary sewer, sanitary laterals, storm sewer and/or storm laterals when ordered replaces by the Board of Public Works due to deterioration or defective condition, when done under public contract shall be assessed at actual cost plus 10% for engineering and overhead.
