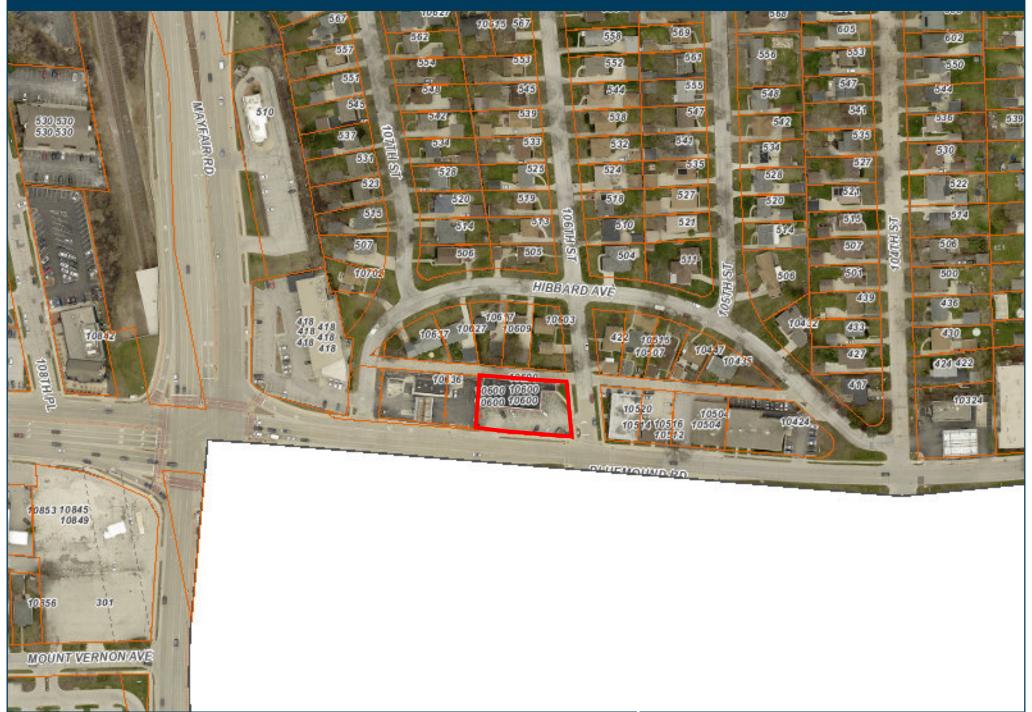

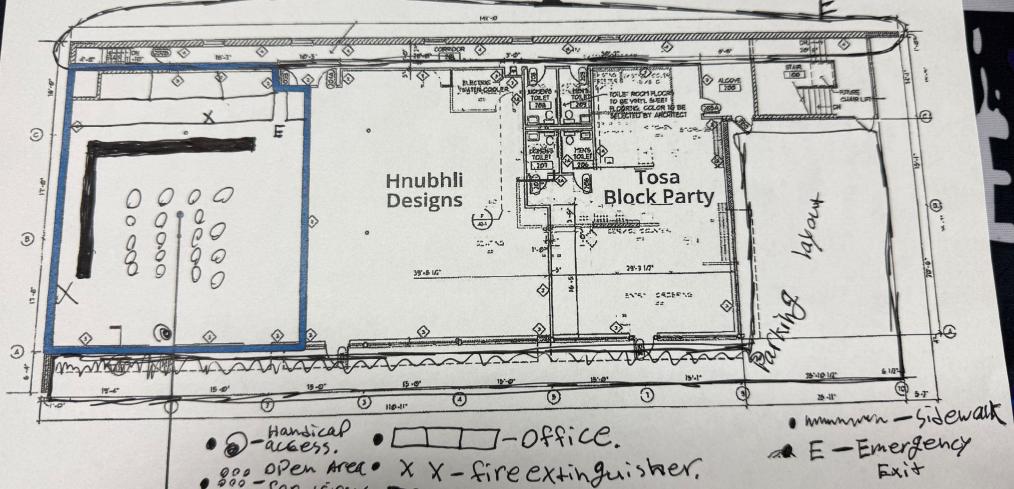

<u>Reconstruction: Type "A" (Asph.) or (Conc.)</u> Completely removing existing curb and gutter and existing pavement, placing new concrete curb and gutter (excluding alleys), and asphalt or concrete pavement surface on a new base.

The above repaving type also includes placing necessary water and sewer service pipes and storm sewer and appurtenances; relaying sanitary sewer and storm sewer as required; relocating existing street lighting system where necessary; constructing new concrete driveway approaches; and replacing concrete sidewalks which are disturbed by other construction, which are defective, or which have a hazard potential.

Repaving Type "B" (Asph.) Completely removing existing curb and gutter, milling the existing asphalt pavement as required, and placing new concrete curb and gutter and asphalt pavement surface on the existing road base.

The above repaving type also includes placing necessary water and sewer service pipes and storm sewer and appurtenances; relaying sanitary sewer and storm sewer as required; relocating existing street lighting system where necessary; constructing new concrete driveway approaches; and replacing concrete sidewalks which are disturbed by other construction, which are defective, or which have a hazard potential.

<u>Repaving: Type "C" (Asph)</u> Milling the existing pavement as required, repairing curbs (and abutting approaches and sidewalks where necessary), and surfacing with asphalt pavement. Also included is the placing of necessary water and sewer service pipes and storm sewer and appurtenances, and relaying sanitary sewer and storm sewer as required.

<u>Repaving: Type "D"</u> Replacing defective curb and gutter, removing, milling and/or pulverizing the existing pavement surface as required, and surfacing with new asphalt pavement. Also included is the placing of necessary water and sewer service pipes and storm sewer and appurtenances, and relaying sanitary sewer and storm sewer as required.

<u>Repaving: Type "E"</u> Replacing minimal defective curb and gutter, minor pavement milling, overlay existing pavement with asphalt pavement. Also included is the placing of necessary water and sewer service pipes and storm sewer and appurtenances, and relaying sanitary sewer and storm sewer as required.

Plaintiff Ascension SE Wisconsin Hospital, Inc. (the "Plaintiff"), by its undersigned counsel, Reinhart Boerner Van Deuren s.c., for its Complaint against the defendant the City of Wauwatosa (the "City"), alleges as follows:

NATURE OF ACTION AND PARTIES

- 1. This action is brought under Wis. Stat. § 74.37(3)(d), for a refund of excessive real estate taxes imposed on Plaintiff by the City for the year 2024, plus statutory interest, with respect to a parcel of real property in the City (the "Property").
- 2. Plaintiff is the owner of the Property, is responsible for the payment of property taxes and the prosecution of property tax disputes involving the Property and is authorized to bring this claim in its own name.

Case 2024CV007161

- 3. The City is a body corporate and politic, duly organized as a municipal corporation under Wisconsin law, with its principal office located at 7725 West North Avenue, in the City.
- 4. The Property is located at 201 North Mayfair Road within the City and is identified in the City's records as Tax Parcel No. 411-9976-007.

JURISDICTION AND VENUE

- 5. The Court has personal jurisdiction over the City pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 801.05(1).
 - 6. Venue is appropriate in Milwaukee County pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 801.50(2)(a).

BACKGROUND FACTS

2024 Assessment - Background Facts

- 7. The Department of Revenue determined that the aggregate ratio of property assessed in the City was 76.6157082% as of January 1, 2023.
- 8. For 2023, property tax was imposed on property in the City at the rate of \$21.404419 per \$1,000 of assessed value of property.
 - 9. For 2024, the City's assessor set the assessment of the Property at \$77,400,000.
- 10. Plaintiff appealed the 2024 assessment of the Property by filing a timely objection with the City's Board of Review pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 70.47 and otherwise complying with all of the requirements of Wis. Stat. § 70.47, except Wis. Stat. § 70.47(13).
- 11. By virtue of a hearing waiver pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 70.47(8m), the Board of Review sustained the 2024 assessment on the merits without a hearing. A true and correct copy of the approved Request for Waiver of Board of Review (BOR) Hearing is attached hereto as **Exhibit A** and is incorporated herein by reference.

- 12. Assuming the 2024 mill rate will be essentially the same as the 2023 mill rate, the City will impose tax on the Property in the approximate amount of \$1,656,702.03.
- 13. Plaintiff will timely pay the property taxes imposed by the City on the Property for 2024, or the required installments thereof.

CLAIM FOR RELIEF

- 14. The allegations of paragraphs 1-13 are incorporated as if fully re-alleged herein.
 2024 Assessment Claim for Relief
- 15. The fair market value of the Property as of January 1, 2024 was no higher than \$17,688,000.
- 16. Based on the aggregate ratio of 76.6157082%, the correct assessment of the Property for 2024 is no higher than \$13,551,786.
- 17. Based on the tax rate of \$21.404419 per \$1,000 of assessed value, the correct amount of property tax on the Property for 2024 should be no higher than \$290,068.
- 18. The 2024 assessment of the Property, as set by the City's Assessor and compared with other commercial property in the City is excessive and, upon information and belief, violates Article VIII, Section 1 (i.e., the Uniformity Clause) of the Wisconsin Constitution. As a result, the property tax imposed on the Property for 2024 may be excessive in at least the amount of \$1,366,634.
- 19. Upon information and belief the City will take the position that the assessment of property in the City is at market value and, if true, then an over assessment of the Property constitutes a Uniformity Clause violation. As a result of the assessment of the Property, the Property bears an unreasonably disproportionate share of taxes on an ad valorem basis.
- 20. Plaintiff is entitled to a refund of 2024 tax in the amount of at least \$1,366,634, or such greater amount as may be determined to be due to Plaintiff, plus statutory interest.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff respectfully requests the following relief:

- A. A determination that the assessment of the Property for 2024 should be no higher than \$13,551,786;
- B. A determination that the correct tax on the Property for 2024 should be no higher than \$290,068;
- C. Judgment in the amount of \$1,366,634, or such greater amount as may be determined due to Plaintiff, plus statutory interest;
- D. An award of all litigation costs incurred by Plaintiff in this action, including the reasonable fees of its attorneys; and
 - E. Such other and further relief as the Court deems appropriate and just.

Private Utilities are underground items that might be installed in your yard that Digger's Hotline will not mark. These are items that were installed by you or a previous owner of the home or building. Private Utilities include invisible (buried) dog fences, gas or electric AFTER the meter that was run from your house to an outbuilding, garage, pool heater, or a gas line to a grill, landscape lighting, parking lot or sign lighting, etc. Our Private Utility Rider is to let you know that Digger's Hotline will not mark these items. Rozga shall not be responsible for damage to nor repair of any of these utilities that Digger's Hotline does not mark. The Private Utility Rider allows you the option to have a private locator locate the path of these items. Please note that because sprinkler / irrigation systems, sump discharge pipes and other private nonmetallic pipes cannot be accurately located, Rozga shall not be responsible for damage to nor repair of those items. If you choose to have Rozga locate your private utilities, the property owner shall make us aware of what private utilities would need to be located.

2. CONSTRUCTION PROCESS

Step 1: Pre-Construction coordination

This will involve Rozgas notification of Diggers Hotline. All utilities, if properly buried, should be a minimum of 18" below the natural surface. If feasible, a pre-construction walk through with the owner or owner's representative may be requested for clarifications of certain site conditions, logistics regarding the coordination of traffic, safety matters, and a review of the overall construction process. Sometimes this coordination is completed at an initial meeting in advance.

Step 2: Scheduling

Our scheduling coordinator or your sales representative/project manager will notify you when work will begin. We make every effort to accommodate our clients' needs regarding scheduling but appreciate your patience when changes occur. There are many variables that affect our schedule, some of which are unfortunately out of our control.

The weather is the single most significant factor that affects our schedule. When weather occurs, we have many clients that are already scheduled. Some of the clients may have specific days or time periods in which the work must be completed, while others may have more flexibility with their scheduling needs. Because of the nature of our work, scheduling changes will also depend on the urgency of the project. For example, a home or business that is out of service due to a sewer or water break will require priority scheduling. In some instances, we might simply need to allow

the project time to "dry out". The drier a property is, the less site impact our construction equipment will make. We take all of this information into account when we revise our schedule. We will communicate any scheduling changes as they occur but certainly appreciate your patience.

As every job requires varying equipment, our crews generally begin each day at 6:30 a.m. which allows them to arrive on most jobsites between 7:30 and 8:30 a.m. Monday through Friday.

Emergency evening and weekend service is available at additional cost. The weather may also affect the schedule.

Please know that we make every effort possible to complete our projects in a timely manner.

Step 3: Work in progress

Our first step is to secure the site. Our goal is to create a safe work environment for our workers and anyone that would be entering or leaving our work site.

Please note that if someone other than the workers on site must enter the work site for any reason, this must be coordinated ahead of time with Rozga to ensure their safety. Once work begins, please be aware that there will be dust and noise throughout the construction process.

The first phase generally entails excavation. There may be other preliminary work that must be completed prior to one of the above-mentioned procedures such as surveying, staking, site clearing, or removals.

If ground water is present, this might result in the requirement of additional pumping. Ground water can also cause instability of soil conditions which might result in (but not limited to): increase in excavation size, additional shoring, etc. Rozga shall notify the owner's representative if any of these changes apply.

Owner shall provide Rozga with a manner of contacting a representative who can approve (in writing) changes that might affect the scope or cost of the project.

Concrete

In the cases where concrete or asphalt restoration needs to be done, generally wait 3 days before it can be driven on but certain things can be done to lessen the time to as short as 24 hours. These processes can be requested but might generate additional cost due to specialty mixes required. Walking traffic is permitted the following day.

Our recommendation is always, longer is better.

Striping in parking lots is not included as part of any concrete or asphalt restoration.

We can refer a company for striping if requested.

3. How is my yard going to be left after the work is complete?

All work is to be rough backfilled only unless otherwise specified on your proposal.

Rough back fill means the excavated area will not be level and will require additional work (not included) to prep for final landscaping. All areas that are excavated and backfilled with excavated material have potential for substantial settling. Potential for settling varies based on soil conditions. Some soils are best left for as long as a year before landscaping should be completed to prevent settling of your new landscaping. It is highly recommended that you refrain from final landscaping until the area has settled. It takes several strong rains to settle. Some people run hoses for a period of time over the area to speed up the settling process.

If hauling of spoil off site is included as part of your proposal, leaving a site relatively flat will tend to settle.

Access to the excavation location will require tracking of heavy equipment and vehicles which may result in rutting. Rutting and wear of soil at stockpiling locations is a common occurrence of this type of work, and restoration is not

included unless otherwise specified on the proposal from Rozga. Please note, that these site impacts will be worse in wet soil than in dryer soil. Scheduling changes could be made due to weather in to minimize these site impacts.

Work performed in right of ways requires Rozga as the permit holder to provide restoration of these areas. If a right of way permit is required, restoration will only be performed within the right of way. This restoration does not include any work performed on private property unless specified on the proposal from Rozga.

Prior to any restoration that is specified to be performed as part of the proposal, span of time will vary between completion of initial work and restoration, due to time of year or weather.

Barricades / Cones / Caution tape to remain on site.

Barricades are left on-site upon completion and will remain until such time that it is safe. If left onsite, please leave onsite until we come back and move them. If any questions about period of time, please call Rozga.

4. How do I know there is not additional damage to my buried pipe beyond the proposed repair location? Due to the nature of underground work, we are limited regarding the ability to determine location of all defects on the underground utilities.

In the case of water lines, the largest leak might show itself, but we cannot guarantee there are not additional leaks. Additional smaller leaks might not be visible prior to exposing the pipe.

In regard to sewer pipes the nature of blockages limits the ability to determine the location of all possible defects. Using a sewer camera with locator will reach the farthest point that is open in the pipe, but the cause of the blockage could be further downstream. This would require sewer cleaning, additional excavation and / or other repairs.

5. What can we do to protect & maintain our utilities for the long term?

In order to achieve the best long term, result it is always recommended to completely replace the utility. However, in the case of a partial repair, to the sanitary or storm systems, regular maintenance would minimize potential for future drainage issues.

WARRANTY

Our warranty is:

1 year from the date of installation for workmanship and materials as per our contract specifications.

Our warranty is specifically for work performed by Rozga Plumbing and Heating Corp. Our warranty does not cover additional defects in the utility we repaired that are found to be present after the completion of our work.

Exclusions and limitations:

Please refer to the contract terms and conditions for a more detailed description of warranty.

At the time we expose utilities we will do our best to visually determine if other defects are present but can only limit this determination to what is exposed and what we can see.

Note: Landscape restoration is not included unless otherwise specified. If desired, we can provide a quote for landscape restoration.

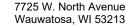

- 8. Under WMC 24.16.040I., a Conditional Use will lapse and have no further effect one year after it is approved by the Common Council, unless a building permit has been issued (if required); the use or structure has been lawfully established; or unless a different lapse of approval period or point of expiration has been expressly established by the Common Council.
- 9. Obtaining other required licenses, permits, and approvals.

Ordinance creating Chapter 3.18 of the Wauwatosa Municipal Code to implement a Vehicle Registration Fee

The Common Council of the City of Wauwatosa do ordain as follows:

Part I. Chapter 3.18 of the Wauwatosa Municipal Code of Ordinances is hereby created to read in its entirety as follows:

Chapter 3.18 Motor Vehicle Registration Fee.

3.18.010 Authority.

This section is adopted pursuant to the authority granted in Wis. Stat. § 341.35, as amended from time to time.

3.18.020 Definition.

For purposes of this section, a "motor vehicle" means an automobile or motor truck registered under Wis. Stat. § 341.25(1)(c) at a gross weight of not more than 8,000 pounds that is registered in Wisconsin and customarily kept in the City of Wauwatosa.

3.18.030 Annual Registration Fee.

An annual City registration fee in the amount of \$15.00 is hereby imposed on all motor vehicles registered in the State of Wisconsin and customarily kept in the City of Wauwatosa beginning on the effective date of this ordinance. Future fee amounts shall be as set in the Consolidated Fee Schedule adopted by the Common Council from time to time.

3.18.040 Collection of fee.

At the time a motor vehicle is first registered and at the time of each registration renewal, the registration applicant shall pay the vehicle registration fee in addition to any fees set by the state and required by Wis. Stat. Ch. 341. The City registration fee shall be paid as provided in Wis. Stat. § 341.35(5), as amended from time to time.

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation shall collect the City registration fee, and shall retain a portion of the moneys collected under this section equal to the actual administrative costs related to the collection of these fees, as provided in Wis. Stat. § 341.35(6m), as amended from time to time.

3.18.050 Exemption.

The following motor vehicles are exempt from the annual vehicle registration fee:

- A. All vehicles exempted by Wis. Stat. Ch. 341 from payment of a state vehicle registration fee.
- B. All vehicles registered by the state for a fee of \$5.00 under Wis. Stat. § 341.26(2).
- C. Any vehicle which is replacing a vehicle for which the annual City vehicle registration fee has already been paid.

Part II. Following its passage and publication, this ordinance shall take effect on April 1, 2025.
