## **NEW BUSINESS**

Tosa Restaurant Week Update

Beth Gleesing provided an update on Tosa Restaurant Week: 2025 was the highest number of participants; Tosa Restaurant Week Landing Page usage up 18.6%, event was successfully promoted through multiple marketing channels.

Muellner Building Update

Beth Gleesing provided an update on the Muellner Building renovations: The Wauwatosa Curling Club has secured 1 international event and 1 national event for the next two curling seasons that should result in room nights for Wauwatosa hotels.

ART 64 Update

Beth Gleesing provided an update on ART 64: artists from 14 states and 2 international artists participated,

winning artist was Jianqiao Luan from Kansas City, MO, total number of vots cast during the event was up 27.6% over 2024, an Artist Market (new component for 2025) resulted in \$13,235 in art sales with Wauwatosa Tourism receiving a commission on the sales, staff currently working on securing attendance data.

### Thomas Dambo Sculpture Update

Beth Gleesing provided an update on the Thomas Dambo sculpture: in November 2022 the Tourism Commission voted to establish Wauwatosa as an arts tourism destination within 5 years; the sculpture installation was approved in January 2023; arts is the fourth-largest driver of tourism; sculpture installation is complete; Grand opening ceremony attended by Lt. Governor Sara Rodriguez, Tourism Secretary Ann Sayers, Representative Robyn Vining, Mayor Dennis McBride, city of Wauwatosa officials and other VIPs; Community response has been tremendous; Social media reach is immeasurable with 2.1 million views on Discover Wauwatosa social media alone; Public Relations efforts successful generating more that 265 hits; Collaborative content with outside partners extended coverage; Wauwatosa businesses are offering troll-themed promotions. Commission is making significant progress towards arts tourism goal.

#### Park Benches Update

Beth Gleesing provided an update: all 5 art benches have been installed in the park and have been well-received, extending art through the park.
