- + Wisconsin Avenue = 30 35 mph
- + Mayfair Road = 40 mph



Reasons For The Project

- + Lack of bicycle accommodations
- + Build a 10-foot-wide multi-use path
 - North side of Wisconsin Avenue (Honey Creek Parkway west to Mayfair Road)
 - Extend the path on the east side of Mayfair Road north (Wisconsin Avenue to Potter Road/Research Drive)







Reasons For The Project

- Improve marked crosswalks along the route to provide safer crossings of Wisconsin Avenue at regular intervals
- Provide a connection to the Oak Leaf Trail at the east
- Provide a connection to the Potter Road
 Path to the west






