Proclamation

Whereas, public works professionals focus on infrastructure, facilities, and services that are of vital importance to sustainable and resilient communities and to public health, high quality of life, and well-being of the people of Wauwatosa;

Whereas, these infrastructure, facilities, and services could not be provided without the dedicated efforts of public works professionals who are responsible for rebuilding, improving, and protecting our City's transportation, water supply, water treatment and solid waste systems, public buildings, and other structures and facilities essential for our citizens;

Whereas, it is in the public interest for the citizens of Wauwatosa to gain knowledge of and maintain an ongoing interest and understanding of the importance of public works; and

Whereas, 2026 marks the 66th annual National Public Works Week sponsored by the American Public Works Association:

Now, Therefore, I, Dennis R. McBride, Mayor of the City of Wauwatosa, hereby designate the week of May 17–23, 2026, as **National Public Works Week** in Wauwatosa and urge all citizens to join with representatives of the American Public Works Association and government agencies in paying tribute to our public works professionals, engineers, managers, and employees, and to recognize the substantial contributions they make to protecting our health, safety, and advancing quality of life for all.
