






2024 Wisconsin public library data | Top 20 municipal population




2025 Wisconsin public library data | Top 20 library visits




2025 Wisconsin public library data | Top 20 reference questions




2025 Wisconsin public library data | Top 20 physical circulation




2024 Wisconsin public library data | Top 20 physical circulation of children's material




2025 Wisconsin public library data | Top 20 staff FTE
