After the 90-day period, what will exist (or maybe no longer exist) that would move this to a formal proposal towards permanent no-parking restrictions in front of our home?

A minor issue is the visual of large temporary no-parking signs in our front yard / view and the potential of the long-term posts. I personally believe this visually changes the neighborhood feel of 84<sup>th</sup> street to a commercial one. While minor, I believe this should be considered – as the neighborhood feel is something all who live and love Tosa understand!!
