



PICKLEBALL COURT RULES

1. PICKLEBALL PLAY ONLY. PLAY AT YOUR OWN RISK.
2. PLAY IS FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED BASIS. LIMIT PLAY TO ONE HOUR WHEN OTHERS ARE WAITING.
3. ONLY PLAYERS ALLOWED ON COURT. WAITING OR WATCHING MUST BE DONE OUTSIDE THE FENCE.
4. TENNIS SHOES ONLY, NO OTHER SHOES ALLOWED.
5. NO SKATEBOARDS, BIKES, OR SKATES OF ANY KIND. NO MOTORIZED VEHICLES.
6. NO SMOKING OR VAPING ALLOWED.
7. NO ANIMALS ALLOWED ON COURT.
8. NO ALCOHOL, DRUGS, ABUSIVE OR FOUL LANGUAGE.
9. NO GLASS CONTAINERS OR FOOD.
10. SURFACE CAN BE SLIPPERY. USE CAUTION.

Pickleball Courts

- Courts are available from dawn to dusk.
- Court rules that apply, first serve unless reserved by Parks and Recreation.
- No weapons, weapons or tournaments without approval from Parks and Recreation.
- Courts are for Pickleball only - NO Golf, Motorbikes, skates, skateboards, inline skates, etc.
- Do Not Use profanity, abusive language or foul language.
- Proper attire and athletic shoes are required.
- Player Rotation when courts are fully reserved:
 - Playing players will place their paddle in the Pickle Rack from left to right.
 - Court time is limited to 3 games to 11, winning by 2 points, 11 or for 3 games max.
 - Court 8 Designated "Challenge Court" for non-reserved play.
 - Court 6 Pickle Rack to used for Challenge Court.
 - Players must choose to queue in either Open Play or Challenge Court, not both simultaneously. Players may change their queue location.
 - Court 8 will be up to no more than 6 minutes.
 - Exit court immediately after your game. To play again place your paddle in the Pickle Rack.
- Please do not clutter the courts while waiting for your turn to play.
- Please report any maintenance concerns to the Parks and Recreation Department.
- Do not use courts when wet.
- Play at your own risk.
