A manifest injustice exists and that granting a variance will be in keeping with the spirit of the code. That the variance will not create special detriment to the overall character of the neighborhood nor adversely affect property values.

That the hardship or practical difficulty was not created by the property owner but exists due to: Previous owner completed the work without permits, geometry of house.

Based upon these findings I move that the variance be granted with stipulations, shall not be used for sleeping or designated as a bedroom. The space must include an egress window compliant with code, hardwired carbon monoxide and smoke detectors, a 7-pound ABC fire extinguisher, and fall protection added to the stairwell.

Amy Sherman, owner of the property at 8915 W Hawthorne Avenue, is requesting a variance to allow 66 inches of headroom in two portions of a basement stairwell, where a minimum of 72 inches is required. Per Chapter VII, Section 30.55(7)(a)1, existing basement stairs must maintain a minimum headroom of 72 inches along the entire flight and

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at the landings on both ends.
