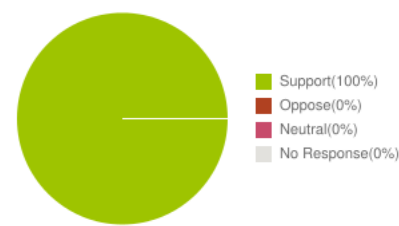

Overall Sentiment



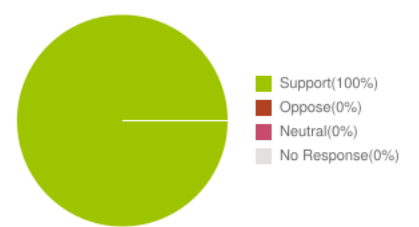

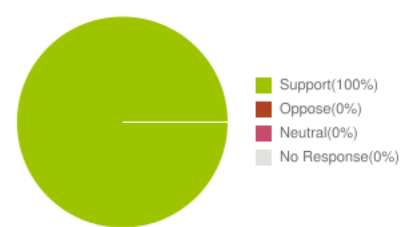
