

Board of Zoning Appeals Members,

Thank you for your consideration of the requested variances for the Wauwatosa Veterans Memorial. The Wauwatosa Veterans Memorial Board asks that you grant these requests.

For clarification, the requested variances are limited to points where the columns for the pergola structures contained in the Memorial are within the setback from Milwaukee and Harwood Avenues to the north and south of the site respectively. It is also important to note that there are no properties adjacent to the requested variances. Adjacent is defined as contiguous. "A lot is not adjacent to another whenever a third strip of land intervenes." (See Brazeau v. DHSS, Wis 2d. 752 (1980)) Harwood and Milwaukee Avenues form the intervening "strip[s] of land" between the requested variances and any other properties. While there is an adjacent property to the west of the Memorial, the pergolas are outside of the required setback from this property.

As this board is aware, when determining whether to grant a variance, it is required to examine whether the four criteria set forth in Wauwatosa Ordinance 24.16.060 are met:

1. Exceptional circumstances exist pertaining to the subject lot;
2. The requested variance is necessary for the preservation and enjoyment of the property rights possessed by other properties in the district and vicinity;
3. The variance will not create special detriment to adjacent property and will not materially impair or be contrary to the purpose and spirit of this ordinance or to the public interests; and
4. The difficulty or hardship was not created by the property owner.

1. Exceptional Circumstances: The history and circumstances surrounding this project, the proposed site and the need for the requested variances are indeed exceptional. This project began in 2019 and has been delayed by four different site changes, design changes, the pandemic, and of course last summer's flooding. Initial proposed sites in the center of Wauwatosa Village were withdrawn by the city. A later proposed site in Hart Park was withdrawn before last year's floods due to floodplain concerns. The subsequent site became untenable after the floods due to the cost of flood mitigation measures and the uncertainty of approval by the Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District. Other locations examined after the floods included Webster Park, Wisconsin Avenue Park and the Medical Complex grounds. The latter two were rejected by Milwaukee County and Webster Park was unsuitable for access and visibility reasons. Through hard work and collaboration with the City, the Memorial Committee located the

current site which has proven to be the only appropriate and available site for immediate construction of the Memorial.

The design (including the pergolas), scale and orientation has been modified several times during three reviews by the Design Review Board. The Memorial melds several components in a unique, personal and inspiring way. The pergolas (modeled after the WWII Memorial in Washington DC) and surrounding vegetation shield the interior to provide a dignified and contemplative space separate from the surrounding city streets. The space will be paved with over 320 personalized bricks, engraved with the names of Veterans, donated by friends and family. Finally, a planned interactive kiosk will provide visitors with an opportunity to learn about the history of our City and its Veterans. The hallowed space will also serve as an informal entryway into the village. In the words of one Design Review Board member, the design combining greenery with the other aspects mentioned above situated at a main entry point into the Village is the “perfect urban project.”

2. Preservation and Enjoyment. The Memorial lends itself to the preservation and enjoyment of the neighboring residences, businesses, schools and places of worship. This is shown by the tremendous support it enjoys. The record contains emails and letters of support from over 60 Wauwatosa residents and/or supporters. 40% of these live within 10 blocks of the site and nearly 25% live within 6 blocks. Patricia McFarland, who lives 2 blocks of the site wrote to say how she will visit the Memorial and remember her brother, a Vietnam Veteran who passed from agent orange exposure. Linda Brown, another neighbor looked forward to “taking grandchildren to this place so we can remember our collective past and look forward to the future together.” Finally, Margaret Arney, 18th District State Representative and nearby resident, commended the Memorial Board’s efforts and expressed how “the location and design are well suited to our community and will add to our shared green space in the Village.”

The project is supported by the Wauwatosa Business Improvement District as a whole and individual businesses. Jessie Cannizarro, president of Milestone Plumbing, believes the Memorial located “in the heart of our community [will] provide students, families, and visitors with a place not only to honor veterans, but also to learn about the sacrifices that have secured our freedoms.” Chris Leffler, owner of Leff’s Lucky Town, anticipates the Memorial will “become an attractive landmark and destination within the Village area.” He thinks “visitors and residents alike will be drawn the site, adding to the character and appeal of Wauwatosa’s historic downtown while reinforcing the values of patriotism, service and community that make our city such a special place to work and live.”

Reverend Patty Pipia of Unity Church at 1717 N 73rd st., (directly across Milwaukee Ave from the site) supports the Memorial. Moreover, as reported by the Milwaukee Business Journal, the City has recently purchased the Unity Church property and any future development will presumably support the current proposal. Finally, both principals for Wauwatosa East High School and Lincoln Elementary Schools, located within 3 blocks of the site, support the Memorial. Principal Steven Plank of Wauwatosa East sees the Memorial as a means for his students to “reflect on citizenship, freedom, and the meaning of democratic values. [Having the] Memorial within walking distance would deepen and enrich those opportunities by providing a tangible place for reflection, learning, and connection.” Of note, Principal Plank, along with Rev. Pipia will allow the use of their respective parking lots to alleviate parking congestion that may result during veteran and community events. Given this, the Memorial will do much more than just preserve the enjoyment of its neighbors and community. It will enhance it.

3. Detriment to Adjacent Property/Public Interest. As stated previously, the requested variance does not affect adjacent properties as there are none adjacent to the north and south setbacks. Rather, Harwood and Milwaukee Avenues intervene between these setbacks and other properties. The only adjacent property as defined by case law is located to the west of the site where the setback is unaffected. The properties nearest the affected setbacks are Unity Church to the North and several houses on Harwood to the South. During 6/26/26 discussions with the Harwood residents at 7313/15, 7331/7333, 7335, 7353 and 7363, at least one resident at each location expressed support for the Memorial. Others at 1708 N 73rd Street, 7322 and 7533/7335 Milwaukee Ave did so as well.

As mentioned earlier, the site has been modified to accommodate concerns that were raised during the approval process. Given that they are frame structures, the pergolas will not obstruct the view of motorists at the intersection. Photometrics have been completed to ensure Memorial lighting will not distract neighbors or passing motorists. Entrances, fencing and vegetation have been placed in a way to prevent pedestrians from “shortcutting” through the Memorial. Finally, cameras will monitor the site for security.

Given the support the Memorial enjoys, its construction and the requested variances are clearly in the public interest. All sitting alders except for one voted in favor of the Memorial at either the Community Affairs Committee Meeting on 5/12/26 or the Common Council Meeting on 5/19/26. During the 5/12 committee meeting Alder Saso, owner of the property to the west of the site, voted for the Memorial saying she was “100% in favor” of it but was concerned about the setbacks and the overhang of the pergola. She made clear that her vote was subject to this board’s determination on

those issues. The overhang has since been removed from the plans and in discussions on 7/2/26, Alder Saso indicated to Memorial Board members that many of her concerns had been resolved. Even the Mayor has repeatedly expressed support for the project in its current location and form. During this year's State of the City Address on 5/14/2026, he recognized the board members and expressed excitement for the Memorial's construction saying he couldn't "wait to join the committee when we finally break ground there, this year." In so doing, he acknowledged the importance of the Memorial to Veterans, families, the neighborhood and Wauwatosa as a whole.

Frankly, this Memorial differs substantially from what this board typically sees. It is not a fence, garage or parking lot that solely affects the property owner and others nearby. When built, it will be a lasting tribute to Veterans and the community they fought to protect. It will send a prominent message to those entering the Village that Wauwatosa treasures its Veterans and the sacrifices they made. Not only is it consistent with the public interest, it represents the values and people our community holds dear.

4. Hardship was not created by property owner. This board may grant a variance based on special conditions where strict enforcement would result in unnecessary hardship to the property owner. Wis Stat. 62.23(7)(e)(7). As previously discussed, The Memorial Committee went to great lengths over several years to locate the proposed site and has modified the design to accommodate the site limitations. Other possible sites were discounted or unavailable. Any additional design changes will delay construction and jeopardize the support of donors, especially those who contributed to specific elements such as the bricks and pergolas and have waited years for it to be built. Denying the variances will result in unnecessary hardship.

Additionally, it is important to note that the Memorial Committee is not the property owner nor will it be after construction. Instead, the site is on City Property and the City will take ownership of the Memorial upon completion. However even if viewed in the position of the property owner, it is clear that the Memorial Committee did not create any hardship. At all points it worked closely with the City to locate the current site. Indeed, the City suggested the site after being provided with the design. When considering whether strict enforcement would result in unnecessary hardship and whether that hardship was self-created, BOZA may consider the role played by municipal officials. (See Accent Developers, LLC v. City of Menomonie BOZA, 2007 Wi App 48). The City owns the site, will own the Memorial and suggested the proposed location. As a City Entity, this board should not be able to deny the variance necessary for construction but at minimum, it cannot find that the Memorial Committee created the hardship when it acted at the direction of the City.

For these reasons, the Memorial Board respectfully requests approval of the variances.

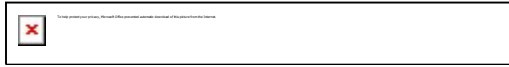

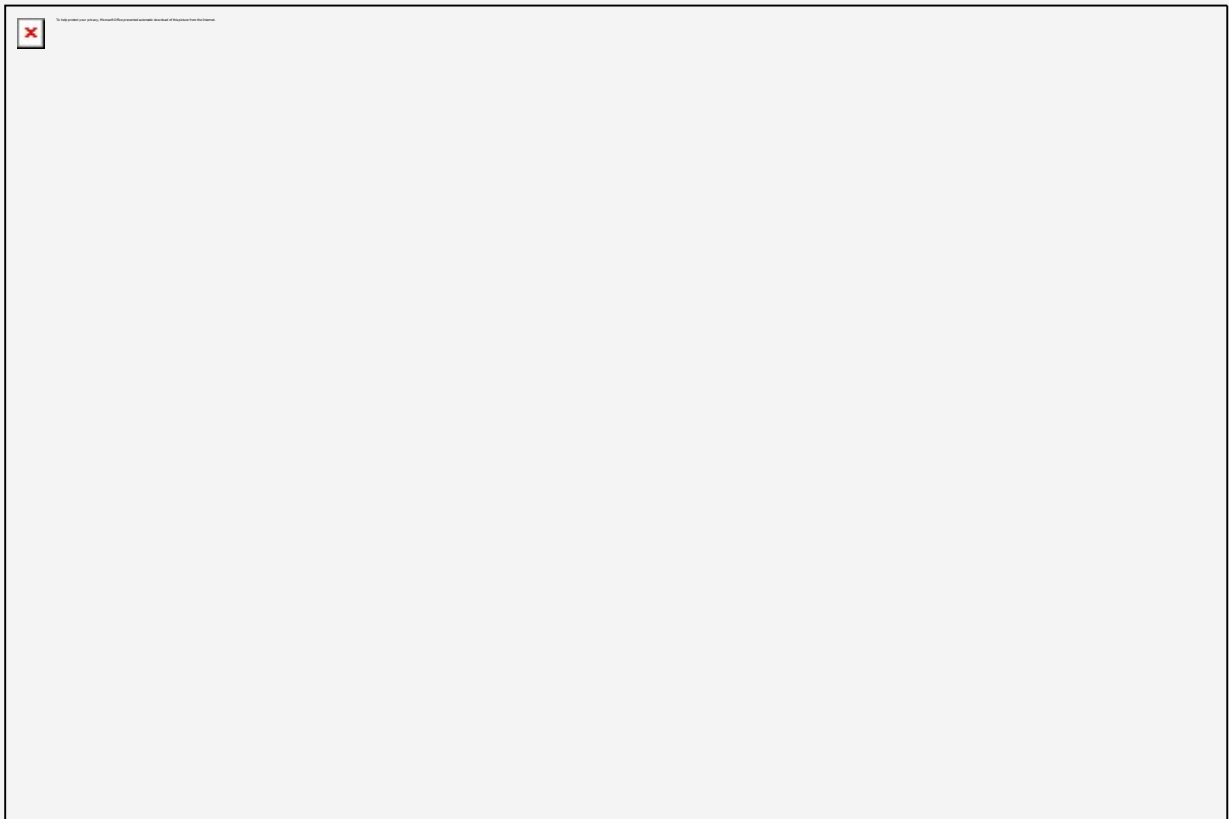

On Friday, June 26, 2026, Bob Wiedel and myself visited homes in the vicinity of the Veterans Memorial at the intersection of Harwood and Milwaukee Avenues.

Out of the 15 homes that were in the area, we were able to talk with about 8 residents. We informed them about the Veterans Memorial that will be built in their area; and informed them that we had received approval from the Design Review Board and the City Common Council. We informed them that our next step was to meet with the Board of Zoning Appeals; as the Memorial's design needed approval as it did not meet the 15' and 25" setback for the pergolas.
